Established last July by Stephen Donnelly, Minister for Health.

Purpose of the Taskforce:

- to identify and support the delivery of specific policy decisions, which will serve to align services and practices that can be delivered by pharmacists, and pharmacies, with the needs of the health service and patients.

Current proposed phases of Taskforce work

Phase 1 July – October 2023

Empowering Pharmacists to Extend Prescriptions.

Work is ongoing to implement this recommendation which is expected to be in place 1 March 2024.

Phase 2 Ongoing Empowering Pharmacists to Prescribe within their scope of Practice.

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





Continuing need, chronic condition

History Unchanged No Adverse Reactions

What we expect



- Record keeping
- Prescriber or GP to be informed
- Instruction 'not to extend'
- Prescribers may issue a Rx for 12 months



What won't change




- Emergency Supply legislation
- Medicine Therapy Review
- The decision not to dispense a prescription
