



NCP for Gender Healthcare

Purpose of the Group:

The HSE National Clinical Programme for Gender Healthcare is being established to deliver a Model of Care for gender healthcare services in Ireland, with an aim of providing safe and effective healthcare for those seeking healthcare services.

This Model of Care is required given the ongoing changes in gender healthcare.

These changes include a developing evidence base, increasing numbers of people being referred to services, and a wider range of clinical needs in the people being referred.

The purpose of the HSE Model of Care for Gender Healthcare is to provide a clinical framework for safe and effective delivery of gender healthcare services in Ireland.

It is not intended to define what it means to be trans or gender diverse.

A Senior Pharmacist with experience of working in gender healthcare is now been sought to join the group.

To provide their expertise to facilitate and assist in the development of the model of care and any future workstreams or initiatives, if required.

Meetings take place mostly online with possibility the first meeting in person. One meeting per month on average with some writing/review to be done in the interim over a projected 1 year timeframe.
