How to Dispense



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Introduction

This user guide is your manual to lead you through every aspect of dispensing on the National Veterinary Prescription System (NVPS), whether as a Licensed Retailer, a Pharmacist or a Locum Pharmacist.

The role of a dispenser as a Licensed Retailer is somewhat different to that of a Pharmacist, as there are differences between what each is legally allowed to dispense.

NVPS Login

To enter the NVPS, go to the link

To dispense using the NVPS application, you need to login to have access to the system.

To login, the dispenser needs to click on the **National Veterinary Prescription System** tab.

If this is the dispensers first time logging into the NVPS, click on **First Time User**.





Prescription Creation

You will need the **Prescription ID** or the **Line Item ID** to be able to correctly search and dispense a prescription

When a vet prescribes veterinary medicinal products, a 16-digit prescription ID is generated. This is sent as a text message to the animal keepers' phone or the vet may print out the prescription ID for the keeper. If a number of medicines are prescribed on the same prescription, a Line ID will be generated for each medicine prescribed which will enable individual items from a prescription to be prescribed. An animal keeper will have to give the Prescription ID or Line Item ID to the dispenser for the medicinal products or feed to be dispensed.

On this screen, you will have confirmation of the prescription number or prescription line-item number.

In addition, on this screen, on top of the screen under the 'Prescription ID', there will be confirmation that this prescription has not been dispensed.



Next, you will select which Veterinary Medicinal Product (VMP) you wish to dispense.



Note: If the initial 16-character number you were given was that of a full prescription, there may be more than one VMP on the screen that may be legally allowed to dispense (e.g. more than 1 antiparasitic VMP, if the prescription was written for more than one antiparasitic VMP). In this case, it is advisable to confirm with the customer which VMP they wish dispensed.

If, however, the initial 16-character number that you were given is that of a prescription line item number, then there will only be the corresponding antiparasitic VMP available to dispense.

The details of the VMP to be dispensed are highlighted in a green-topped text box. Within this box there will also be a description of the animal/animals for which the medicine was prescribed. In this case, the Bimectin 1% solution for injection was prescribed for '2023 Born Replacement Heifers'.

NOTE: If you are dispensing the entirety of the prescription, (in this case 15,000ml or 15L) then the prescription will be marked as dispensed in its entirety and will not allow further dispensing against this prescription, irrespective of whether that attempt is made at the same dispenser premises or another.





Screen 8 - Dispense History Search

When you enter dispense History you will see a search bar and a number of filters

You can search by either Keeper name, Prescription ID or Herd number. Feel free to use any other filter you need like the prescription status (Active, Completed, Expired, Cancelled) or animal type.



Once you have selected what you want to be searching by you can enter the data, in this case the name of the Keeper, and press on the search button.

You can now click on “view details” to be able to see all details on that dispense action including animal details, the treatment dispensed and if there is still treatment left to dispense you can dispense it from there.
